- 1) Prepare students to become moral leaders in the community. Students will:
 - * Study Jesus and learn to exemplify love in the way he did
 - * Become well versed in Biblical Truths about morality and virtue
 - * Explore and appreciate various cultures while responding to calls for action
 - * Volunteer within the community and learn about the ways they can help others
- 2) Prepare students to participate in a global community. Students will:
 - * Use technology to communicate with others
 - * Use project-based lessons to better understand global happenings
 - * Learn foreign language to communicate with a member of another community
- 3) Prepare students to **solve problems**. Students will:
 - * Create and answer their own questions
 - * Learn through history, and learn different methods for solving problems
 - * learn to create research-based science projects and reports from various perspectives
- 4) Prepare students to communicate effectively. Students will:
 - * participate in a variety of writing styles and projects
 - * practice speech and debate in class
 - * Use formal and informal philosophy to construct arguments
- 5) Prepare students to **become responsible adults.** Students will:
 - * Learn to appreciate personal growth and manage life's essential needs including nutrition, finances and legalities
 - * Learn to manage personal finances, including taxes
 - * Learn to develop goals and set paths to reach them
